

Jane Rutter is one of the most outstanding musical personalities in Australia. In 2016, Jane was awarded one of France's most distinguished honours, that of Chevalier de l'Ordre des Arts et Lettres, in recognition of her services to Music and the Arts. She has been Artistic Director of Live at Lunch since its inception in 2013. A classical trailblazer, and household name in Australia, she has devoted her life to pushing the boundaries of French flute playing and expanding classical and fine music repertoire across musical genres.
